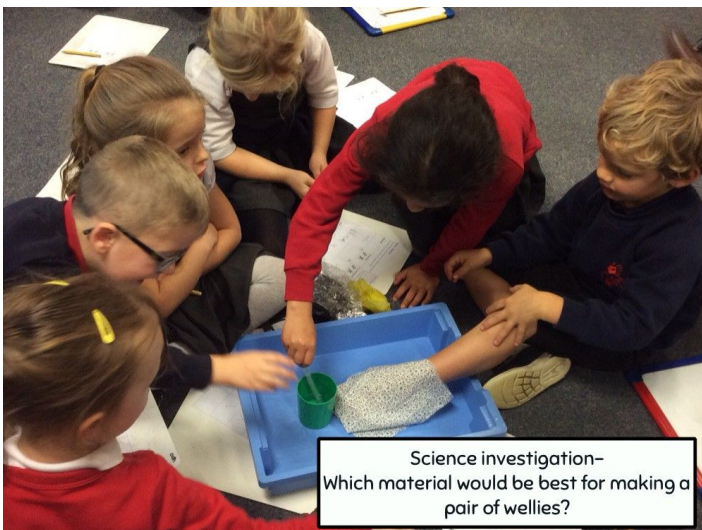


Science at CwR

The National Curriculum, with its dual focus on scientific knowledge and enquiry skills, is at the heart of our science teaching at CwR.

All lessons are structured around the statutory Knowledge and Understanding requirements specified in the curriculum, with many sessions containing a dual focus where we advance the children's enquiry skills alongside this knowledge.

As well as developing our children's knowledge of scientific concepts, encouraging them to become independent, enquiring scientists is our other key aim. To ensure that our children develop their use of enquiry skills we have mapped out the National Curriculum's Working Scientifically objectives throughout school, so that children have time to both consolidate and develop their skills of working like scientists as they progress through each year group.



Our recent pupil survey revealed that children thoroughly enjoy their science sessions and part of this was due to the hands-on nature of the subject. Wherever possible, we aim for sessions to contain a practical element where children can interact with the school's extensive bank of science resources to reinforce and develop their understanding of scientific concepts.
