Please can we kindly remind you that PE & Forest School kits should be brought into school on a Monday and stay in school until the Friday so children always have their full kit available for all lessons.

Forest school kit should include waterproof trousers and jacket, and wellies.

PE kit should include a white t-shirt, black shorts, spare socks, trainers, jumper and tracksuit bottoms for when it is colder.

When your child's learning group is due to do art, could they please bring an apron or an old shirt to wear.

Could you please make sure that on all PE days your child is not wearing any jewellery, particularly, earrings should not be worn unless your child can take them out on their own. Long hair needs to be tied back.

Could you please ensure that all PE kit, forest kit and bags are clearly labelled with your child's name and learning group.

Letters will be sent home to parents for those children without the correct kit.
