

Key Stage 1 - Weekly News, w/c 28.9.20



Year 1

In Maths, we will be counting and representing numbers.

In English, we will be continuing with our class book 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers and will be rehearsing and writing sentences.

Our topic subject this week is music. We will be using body percussion to create and perform a short rhythm to represent an animal's movements.

Year 2

In English, we will be focusing on writing some coherent and well punctuated sentences to describe the settings in our class story 'Here We are' by Oliver Jeffers.

In Maths, we are continuing with our place value and partitioning two digit numbers using part whole models.

In topic, we will be using body percussion to create and perform a short rhythm to represent an animal's movements.

Year 2 will be starting homework on Seesaw this week. We will begin with one maths and one English task on alternate weeks. This week there will be a maths task on partitioning numbers into tens and ones. Please alert your class teacher if you have any issues accessing Seesaw for homework.
