

Key Stage 1 - Weekly News, w/c 12.10.2020



Year 1

In phonics this week we will be focusing on the long /oo/ sound and learning alternative ways to write this sound.

In Maths, we will be counting forwards and backwards and identifying numbers on a missing number line.

Our topic subject this week is geography. We will be learning simple compass directions and following simple directions to locate features on a map.

Year 2

In English, we will be collecting exciting vocabulary to describe fireworks.

In phonics we will be recapping different ways to spell the long /ee/ sound (ea, e-e, ie/ey/y).

In Maths, we are partitioning numbers into tens and ones and recalling number bonds to 10 and 20. The homework this week on Seesaw will help you learn your number bonds.

Our topic subject this week is geography. We will be using compass directions and using locational and directional language to describe the location of features on a map.
