## Y5 Big Street Survey Activity



Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of Clifton with Rawcliffe Primary School's efforts to encourage active travel to school, your child will be taking part in the Sustrans Big Street Survey on week commencing 2<sup>nd</sup> November. This will involve taking your child's learning group to survey streets in the local area. We hope to use the children's ideas to start a conversation about the top actions our school community can take to further encourage active travel. We also hope to identify possibilities for improving the street environment around school.

We are planning to do the survey on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November (Y5S/Y5PH), Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> November (Y5H)/Y5PH) and Friday 6<sup>th</sup> November (Y5S/Y5H). Each class will take part in two sessions. The first will be fieldwork that takes place outdoors and the second will be follow up work which will be completed in school. **We ask that you ensure your child has weather appropriate clothing on the day of their first session.** In particular, please make sure they have a coat and appropriate footwear to spend **approximately an hour outside.** A follow up session is dependent on the fieldwork being completed, so the fieldwork will take place in all but extreme conditions.
