



Year 1

In Maths next week we will be comparing numbers using 'more than' and 'less than'.

In Phonics we will be looking at alternative ways to make the /air / sound and /c/ sound. We will also be practising our writing by adding captions to pictures.

We will be continuing our topic in science by learning about properties of materials and carrying out a simple experiment.

In PSHE this half-term we have been exploring similarities and differences between people in our class, friendships and our dreams and goals.

Year 2

In English, we will be planning and beginning to write our own versions of the story of 'The 3 Little Pigs' using storymaps and talk4writing.

In phonics we will be revising alternative graphemes for the /or/ sound ('aw', 'au', 'al').

In Maths we will be looking at related number facts and continuing to compare number sentences.

Our topic subject this week is DT. We will be making a moving wheel mechanism with decoration inspired by the story 'The Dot'.

In PSHE this half-term we have been exploring similarities and differences between people in our class, friendships and our dreams and goals.
