



Year 1

In English this week, we will be continuing with our story 'Jesus' Christmas Party' and will be filling in missing words in sentences to check our writing makes sense.

In Maths, we will be recapping our learning of greater than and less than.

In Phonics we will be looking at alternative ways to the /ss/ sound.

Our topic subject this week is RE. We will be learning about special celebrations.

In PSHE this half-term we have been exploring similarities and differences between people in our class, friendships and our dreams and goals.

Year 2
