



Year 1

In Maths, we are focusing on addition and subtraction and looking at part-whole models.

In Phonics we will be looking at alternative ways to the /j/ sound.

In English, we will be editing and improving our own versions of the story of 'The 3 Little Pigs' and exploring calligrams.

In phonics we will be continuing to consolidate our knowledge of the phonics sounds and looking at the spelling rule for the /s/ sound spelt with the letter 'c'.

In Maths we will be using our number bonds to 10 to add a two-digit and one-digit number crossing 10s.

Our topic subject this week is RE. We will be finding out about Muslim beliefs and listening to a story about the prophet Muhammad. We will also be busy with our Christmas play rehearsals!

In PSHE this half-term we have been exploring similarities and differences between people in our class, friendships and our dreams and goals.
