Last week, the children in year 3 and 4 have been learning, practising and chanting their timetables. We have been finding out about World War One, Remembrance and why we wear poppies. We all observed a two minute silence to remember those who have lost their lives in different conflicts around the world.

Our learning this week includes:

Class Book: War Games by Michael Foreman

English: Grammar - Homophones, Writing - War Poetry

Reading: Key reading skills (inference, retrieval, prediction and summarising), Reading fluency and stamina.

Maths: Y3 Multiplication and division; Y4 Multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100

History: World War 1.

Art: Poppy art

Science: Year 3: light; Year 4: sound

PPA PSHE: Topic - Together we can.

Children will have an understanding of:

- How to make friends.
- Know how to stay safe.

Class PSHE: Topic - Celebrating Differences.

Children will have an understanding of:

- Accept that everyone is different.

RE: Why are festivals important to religious communities?

Reminders for the week:

- PE will be on **Monday and Tuesday**. Earrings need to be removed before school if children can't do this independently.
- As usual, **homework** will be sent home on Google Classroom on **Fridays**. The work needs to be completed online before the following **Thursday**. Children who don't have time to complete this at home will have the opportunity to do it on Friday lunchtimes.
