



Year 1

In Maths, we will be recapping addition and subtraction and looking at part-whole models.

In Phonics we will be looking at alternative ways to the /n/ and /r/ sounds.

Our topic subject this week is Music. We will be using instruments to make a Christmas sound scape.

In English, we will be writing sentences on a storyboard about the Innkeeper.

In PSHE this half-term we have been exploring similarities and differences between people in our class, friendships and our dreams and goals.
