



Year 1

In Maths we will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, forwards and backwards, and using this knowledge to solve problems.

In Phonics we will be continuing to learn alternative spellings for some sounds.

In English we will be reading 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Drew Daywalt and Oliver Jeffers and using this book as a stimulus for writing.

Our topic is Spring and we will be going for a Spring walk around school and doing some observational drawings of Spring flowers.

In PSHE this half-term we will be learning about online safety: relationships and being safe when using devices.

Year 2

In English, we will be beginning to write our own 'voice' based on Voices in the Park by Anthony Browne.

In Maths we will be continuing to look at 3D shapes. We will be investigating and learning about their properties including faces, edges and vertices.

In Geography, we will be learning to name and locate the countries and capitals of the UK.

In PSHE this half-term we will be looking at how to keep our bodies and minds healthy.

*Please note that **Wednesdays and Thursdays are PE days** for KS1.*

*For **Wednesday PE**, children do not need to bring any extra kit as they will be able to participate in their school uniform and the trainers they wear to school.*

*For **Thursday PE and outdoor activities**, children should come to school wearing suitable outdoor clothes that they can wear all day.*

Children should not be wearing earrings on PE days unless they can remove them by themselves.
