



Year 1

In Maths we will be recapping addition and subtraction on a number line, and recognising tens and ones in a 2-digit number.

In Phonics we will be continuing to learn alternative spellings for some sounds.

In English we will be writing a letter to the crayons, based on our knowledge of the book 'The Day the Crayons Quit'.

Our topic is Geography and we will be learning about the four countries of the UK. We will also be doing some science investigation as part of science week in school. On Monday, we will have a special visitor coming who is going to help us carry out a special Easter challenge experiment.

In PSHE this half-term we will be learning about online safety: relationships and being safe when using devices.

Year 2

In English, we will be editing and uplevelling our fifth voice story based on Voices in the Park by Anthony Browne.

In Maths we will continue to work on our arithmetic skills using the four operations.

In RE, we will be learning about different sacred texts and comparing the similarities between them.

In our science week activities we will be investigating and observing changes as well as sorting and classifying. On Wednesday, we have a special visitor coming who is going to help us carry out a special Easter challenge experiment.

In PSHE this half-term we will be looking at how to keep our bodies and minds healthy.

*Please note that **Wednesdays and Thursdays are PE days** for KS1.*

*For **Wednesday PE**, children do not need to bring any extra kit as they will be able to participate in their school uniform and the trainers they wear to school.*

*For **Thursday PE and outdoor activities**, children should come to school wearing suitable outdoor clothes that they can wear all day.*
