**Our learning this week includes:**

**Class Book:** Y3 Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Y4 Kensuke's Kingdom

**English:** Newspaper report writing.

**Reading:** Key reading skills (inference, retrieval, prediction and summarising), Reading fluency and stamina.

**Maths:** Y3 Fractions, Y4 Fractions, decimals

**Spanish:** Using familiar language

**History:** War of the Roses

**Science:** Y3 Animals including Humans, Y4 Animals including Humans.

**PSHE:** Topic - **Healthy Me**

Children will have an understanding of:

In Year 4 we will be covering -

In Year 3 we will be covering -
