

Key Stage 1 - Weekly News, w/c 1.11.2021



Year 1

In Maths, we will be beginning to learn about subtraction.

In English, we will be reading 'The Elves and the Shoemaker' and writing sentences about the story using adjectives.

In history we will be comparing old and new toys.

Year 2

In English, we will be reading the story Tatty Ratty by Helen Cooper and collecting new vocabulary to use in our writing.

In Maths, we will be using our number bonds to 10 to a two-digit and a one-digit number together where we are going across a ten boundary. For instance, to do $28 + 5$ we will use our knowledge that $8 + 2 = 10$ to know that $28 + 5$ is the same as $30 + 3$.

In history we will be learning about changes in living memory by looking at how old and modern toys are different.

Homework will be uploaded to Seesaw every Friday for Year 1 and Year 2 starting on Friday 5th November. Please submit each homework on Seesaw before the following Friday.

In PSHE our KS1 topic this half term is Celebrating Difference. We will be learning about what makes us unique and how to respect each other.
