KS1 Trips to York landmarks on 8th & 9th March

In March all KS1 children will go on a trip into York in connection with our topic 'On Your Doorstep'. We will travel into town by bus and spend some time walking through York looking at some key landmarks. **Y2 will go on the 8th March and Y1 on the 9th March.**

This will be a half day trip and we will be back at school in time for lunch. As we will be walking outside whatever the weather please ensure that children are suitably dressed for the weather including a waterproof coat and shoes that are appropriate for walking (children may wear trainers instead of school shoes if you wish but must be in school uniform).

What to bring

- A small backpack/rucksack so they can have their hands free.
- A water bottle- we will send the school water bottles home the evening before so parents can wash and fill these up for the trip. Please keep in your child's backpack. **Water will NOT be provided in order to reduce the use of single use plastics, so please ensure your child has their own water bottle.**

Please ensure that ALL items are clearly named. Thank you.

We will need some additional adult helpers on this trip, so please fill in the slip below **indicating if you are available to come with us on this trip.** Please note that parents will not be in direct supervision of their own child's group.

Permission for your child to take part is presumed unless we hear otherwise.
