Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 3 and 4 visit to Bridlington beach

We are writing to inform you that the school has arranged a visit to Bridlington beach, for the Year 3 and Year 4 children. Both year groups will go together on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022**. The children are to arrive at school at **8:30 am**. They will leave after morning registration and return to school at the later time of **5pm**. **Due to the later return time all children must be collected at 5pm by an adult.**

The cost of the trip will be **£11 per child**, which covers the cost of travel. This will be paid for from Enrichment contributions collected at the beginning of the school year.

The children do not need to wear their school uniform but please ensure they have sensible non-slip shoes, preferably trainers. They will be spending all day outside, carrying out school related activities on the beach. Can you please make sure that they bring with them: a suitable coat, waterproof trousers, sun cream and a hat, to prepare for all weather conditions. They will also require a packed lunch for the day, and can we kindly remind you not to give glass bottles or fizzy drinks. If your child is entitled to free schools meals, a packed lunch will be provided by school. Please also ensure your child also has their water bottle with them, which can be refilled at the beach.

During the day children will have the opportunity to paddle in the sea. We will only take a small group of children at any one time and the activity will be fully supervised. Please can children bring a small towel. You may also wish your child to wear beach shoes during this activity.

The children will also be taking part in a sand castle building competition with their class. Children are welcome to bring a bucket and spade for this activity, but they will have to be responsible for these items.
