FS1

A big thank you to everyone for the effort put in on 'Rock Star Day'. The children looked amazing and loved dancing and playing their guitars. We have also loved holding the little chicks this week. We've been amazed by how much they have grown each day.

Phonics

In phonics the children will sing loudly like a lion and quietly like a mouse. They will also play a game of 'copycat' and will follow the sounds made by their friends.

Topic

We will continue to watch the caterpillars as they grow and will learn more about their life cycle. We will make repeating pattern caterpillars and will create symmetrical butterflies.

Maths

In maths we will match the foods the Hungry Caterpillar ate with the correct numeral. For example he ate 4 strawberries. We will also use the language of more than and fewer than as we compare the dots on the ladybirds.

PSHE

We will think about keeping clean this week and will discuss why it is important to wash our hands before we eat lunch and after we have been to the toilet.

FS2

We have had a really exciting week this week! The children looked amazing in their rock star outfits and did a fantastic job at making their shakers. We have also had a chance to properly meet the chicks and we will miss having them in school.

On Monday, the 'Big Walk and Wheel Challenge' begins. It's free to enter and we would love everyone to be involved. The aim of this is inspire pupils to make

active journeys to school and improve air pollution quality in their neighbourhood. This will run from the 20th March to 31st March.

Phonics

In Phonics, we will be recapping phase 3 sounds and tricky words.

Maths

In maths we will consolidate our learning on numbers 9 and 10. We will be looking at the composition of each number and practising writing addition and subtraction number sentences. We will also do some starters on 2d shapes and patterns.

Topic

In Topic next week we be learning about life cycles of caterpillars and reading 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' story.

RE

In RE we will be looking at special places, focussing on churches, ahead of our visit on Friday 24th March.

PSHE

We will continue the topic 'Healthy Me' and learn about the importance of keeping clean. With a particular focus on why washing our hands is so important.
