On your child's PPA day, they are allowed to come to school in their outdoor PE kit and stay in it for the remainder of the day. Outdoor PE kit should include a plain white t-shirt under a black, grey or navy jumper (without hood), black shorts and/or black, grey or navy jogging bottoms, spare socks and trainers. Your child also needs to have a water bottle. Could you please make sure that on all PE days your child is not wearing any jewellery. Earrings should not be worn unless your child can take them out themselves. Tape to cover over earrings is not allowed. Long hair needs to be tied back.

Please can we kindly remind you that Forest School kits should be brought into school on a Monday and stay in school until the Friday so children always have their full kit available for all lessons. Forest school kit should include waterproof trousers, jacket and wellies. Could you please ensure that forest kit and bags are clearly labelled with your child's name and learning group.

Letters will be sent home to parents for those children without the correct kit.
