Y6 Walking trip to York - Monday 5th June 2023

On Monday 5th June, which is the first day back after half term, all Year 6 children will go on a trip into York to support us in writing our own "Guide to York". We will be walking into town and taking part in a guided tour of the city landmarks.

This will be a full day trip, therefore children will require a packed lunch, including a drink, which we will eat in the city centre. We kindly remind you not to include glass bottles or fizzy drinks. Please send your child's packed lunch in a carrier bag which can be thrown away afterwards - this will avoid the need for children to carry lunchboxes during the afternoon. If your child is currently entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided. If you prefer to provide your own please let your child's teacher know via DoJo.

As we will be walking to and from town please ensure that children are suitably dressed for the weather on the day including sun cream and a sun hat if sunny. Shoes that are appropriate for walking (children may wear trainers instead of school shoes if you wish but must be in school uniform).

The cost of the trip is £3.50 per child. We do appreciate that we are currently asking for Enrichment contributions for the Countryside Day, however this trip is linked directly to our English curriculum in school and we would be very grateful if you are able to support us.

Please log into your ParentPay account by Thursday 1st June to contribute and give permission for your child to attend the trip.
